

#### Manual for the end user and the installer:

Dear customer,

Thank you for purchasing one of our Patio Covers. This manual provides all the necessary information to quickly become familiar with the product. We kindly ask you to read this information carefully before working with the product.



This manual is intended for the end user and installers. We recommend that the assembly of this construction be carried out by (at least) 2 qualified persons.

The assembly of the product is described in 2 chapters:

- 1: Preparation for assembly (from page 1)
- 2: Assembly (from page 10)

This is the original manual, look after it!

#### **Product Description:**

The Patio Cover may only be used to cover a terrace. Any use, other than defined here, is seen as unintended use. The manufacturer cannot be held responsible for any (consequential) damage caused by unintended, improper or unwise use.

#### Symbols used:



This symbol means that the product is not included and you have to purchase it yourself.



This symbol means that you must use the supplied screw. The type and number of screws are shown beneath the image.

#### **Environmental conditions:**

This product is intended for outdoor use and may get wet.

#### **Tools Required:**

- Stanley knife or scissors
- Drill Ø 5mm
- Hole Saw Ø 82mm
- Cordless power drill
- Hacksaw
- Cartridge gun with silicone sealant
- Cleaning tools and cleaning products
- Pencil
- Hammer
- Mounting fixings
- Acrow props
- Shovel
- Spirit level
- Measuring tools (tape measure or ruler)
- Climbing equipment (step ladders or mobile scaffolds)

#### **Precautions and Safety Instructions:**

#### Warning!

- If your Patio Cover contains lighting or heating, the electrical installation may only be carried out by a qualified installer.
- The end user is responsible for the correct installation and use of the product. Improper assembly or improper use may cause damage to, or a defect in, the product. The warranty is void if the product and/or the electronic components are damaged due to improper assembly or use.
- Observe local laws and regulations when assembling and/or using the product.

#### Please note!

- Mounting materials that are not included must be purchased separately because each situation requires different fixings and depends on the substrate or construction to which it needs to be affixed. Always seek advice from a specialist building supplier about what is required in your particular situation and only use stainless steel fixings.
- All screws should be carefully tightened with a torque of 1.0 Nm. Make sure you tighten the screws with caution, when screwing into soft materials like aluminium, screws can easily get "stripped".
- When unpacking, check that all parts are present and check all components for possible damage.
- Contact your supplier if any parts are missing or damaged, if possible, take photographs of any damaged packaging and parts.

#### Maintenance, environment and disposal:

 Clean the product when dirty or at least every 6 months to ensure a longer product life.



The symbol on the material, the accessories or packaging indicates that this product may not be treated as household waste. Dispose of the device through a collection point for recycling waste electrical equipment




Drill the Gutter reinforcement profiles according to the above Details and dimensions






Drill the Gutter reinforcement profiles according to the above Details and dimensions






Drill the Wall profiles according to the above dimensions and Details shown in step 4




Drill the Wall profiles according to the above Details and Dimensions as shown in step 3




Drill the Post according to the above Detail and Dimensions and cut them to size if mounting on the floor!





Drill the Angle Plates as shown in above Details




Thoroughly degrease the edge of the Glasss on the side where the condensation profile will be mounting. Apply a thin layer of silicone sealant in the condensation profile.


Press the condensation profile on the bottom of the Glasss and immediately remove and clean the excess silicone sealant. Let the Glasss pane with the condensation profile dry for a short time until it is bonded and after that mount the Glasss pane carefully in the roof construction.













Attach the U-elements to the floor and the 1st part of the Wall profile according to the above dimensions! Floor and wall fixings are NOT included, they must be purchased separately because each situation requires different fixings and depends on the substrate or construction to which it needs to be affixed. Always seek advice from a specialist building supplier about what is required in your particular situation and only use stainless steel fixings!






Mount the 2nd part of the Wall profile level on the wall! Check the squareness of the Patio Cover with the diagonal measurements!





Slide the first 2 posts over the U brackets and keep them 10 mm from the floor due to drainage! Use 7 mm shims to temporarily keep the posts up and screw the posts to the U brackets!




Assemble the first part of the Gutter and assemble the first Side support!

Advice: preferably use acrow props for temporary support!


Glue the Gutter connector into the first Gutter section, thoroughly degrease them both beforehand! Mount the End plates to the left end of the Gutter and the Wall profiles!






Assemble the first intermediate support (cut to size), check again to ensure everything is still straight, square and level! Thoroughly seal the Gutter and End plate connection to ensure it is watertight!










Advice: Place the first Glasss sheet in the first section, this sheet ensures that the roof surface stays square!


Attach the right Support!

Seal the Gutter Endplate as shown in Details above!










Assemble the remaining intermediate Supports according to the setting out shown above! Mount the End plates to the right end of the Gutter and the Wall profiles!






Install the Leaf trap!

Install the remaining Glasss roofing sheets and fit the rubber cover seals!

Note: Leave the cover seals a little too long and push them `butting` into the roof rails so that they are mounted as relaxed as possible to prevent shrinkage due to solar heat!

Then cut the Cover seals at the bottom of the Gutter to size!






Fix the Angle plates with 4.2x32 screws!











